#### Principal's Report - I. Sauve

- Population has increased from 431 and now at 436 students
- Projections are showing that we may lose a class and as a result one staff member (57 grade 8s are graduating)
- Term 1 begins on February 1st; At the end of term 1, Mrs.
   Freeman (Gr1-3 Phys Ed + Science) is moving to a new school
- Mr. Herter will begin at the beginning of Term 2 with a transition period with Mrs. Freeman
- EQAO updates:
  - Goal of EQAO preparation: Building confidence in EQAO for students in advance of testing
  - Can we include links to the EQAO prep test questions in SWAY in preparation?
  - EQAO tests will continue to be completed electronically
  - New focus for EQAO for the school board Confidence in math (emphasis on Gr 2 + Gr 5 in preparation for EQAO testing next year). Grade 2+5 teachers will have some relief for professional development to help build confidence in math from January through to March.
    - Math confidence doesn't always align with math achievement
