- 3. School uniform
 - DPCDSB recently amended the <u>dress code</u> which specifies that torso and upper legs to mid-thigh are not exposed
 - ii. Parents have approached Isabel Sauve for school uniforms citing equity reasons
 - iii. In order to gauge community interest, there is a Board policy around school uniforms inquiries: There will be a mandatory school-wide survey sent out for families to vote yes/no in regards to uniforms
 - iv. In order to move forward, 60% in agreement of uniforms is required (1 vote per family of total family population; not of who voted)



- v. Should uniforms move forward, there will be a committee formed to inform what uniforms would look like; Roll out of uniforms would not start until next year (2025-2026)
 - a. Uniform option 1: Official uniforms (a la lona with crest) vs. Uniform option 2: unofficial uniforms (hybrid approach - similar unbranded clothingin the right colours - more like a colour dress code)
- vi. Support required for families in need and accommodations for kids with sensory concerns

4. Yearbook

- i. We are starting a school wide year book that has been a grade 8 only initiative in the past
- ii. Andrew Lionis + Isabel Sauve will lead a yearbook committee along with students
- iii. Will look at fundraising efforts to reduce yearbook costs to families (Yearbooks typically cost \$20-\$25 per copy)

5. Money for pumpkins

- i. St. Chris classes had 1 pumpkin for every classroom + door decorating contest last year and would like to continue with this tradition
- ii. Funding for pumpkins Approved (18 classrooms + 1 office) for pumpkin decorating contest
- iii. Donation to Whiteoaks Association Pumpkin Walk post contest

- i. Council is looking into alternative vendors for Pizza Day (Gino's Pizza, Dough Box, and Pizza Nova)
